



About Your Prescription Drug Coverage

Prescription coverage is provided as part of both medical plans. Your cost for prescriptions depends on your medical plan, where you fill prescriptions, type of medication, and the day supply.

Advantages of using the health system pharmacy

The health system pharmacy provides the best **price** and the most **convenience**:

- Fill prescriptions electronically
- Expert counseling by phone or email
- Prescriptions delivered free to home
- No in-person visit required

Requirements for maintenance and specialty medications

The health system pharmacy must be used for all maintenance and specialty medications.

What type of prescription do I have?

Medications fall into three types:

- Acute: to treat short-term symptoms for a specified time.
- Maintenance: require long-term, regular use to treat a chronic health condition.
- Specialty: high-cost medications used to treat a chronic or complex health condition.

What will I pay for my prescription drugs?
