About Your Prescription Drug Coverage

Prescription coverage is provided as part of both medical plan choices available for 2021. Your cost for prescriptions will depend on which medical plan you choose and where prescriptions are filled.

Advantages of using the health system pharmacy

The health system pharmacy provides the best **price** and the most **convenience**:

Fill prescriptions electronically

- Expert counseling by phone or email
- Prescriptions delivered free to home
- No in-person visit required

Requirements for maintenance and specialty medications

On January 1, 2021, the health system pharmacy will be the exclusive provider for:

- Maintenance medications —long-term, regular use to treat chronic health conditions
- Specialty medications high-cost drugs to treat chronic or complex health conditions

These medications must be filled by the health system pharmacy in 2021. Those in Greater Kansas may use Reed Pharmacy in Larned and Sterling, and The Medicine Shoppe in Great Bend for maintenance medications. Specialty medications must be filled by the health system pharmacy.
